The majority of the people were suffering from knee pain, swelling, and high/low B.P. The patients were provided the treatment and medicines were distributed free of cost .

Smokeless tobacco such as chewing tobacco and snuff also increases the risk of cancer, especially oral cancers. Both behavioural interventions like counselling and medication can help addicts quit their habit.

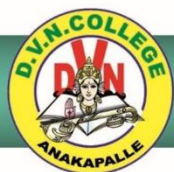
Mr. Anand Rao, who runs the home, was overwhelmed and said that the students had come with a lot of preparation, enthusiasm and with good intentions.
